Staffing for September

As we are approaching the end of the school year, I'd like to take a moment to outline how we intend to set up in September.

We will be running in **five** classes next year: Nursery and Reception will be in our **Early Years** class. It will be led by Miss McNamee, with Mrs Robson, Mrs James, Miss Glencross and Mrs Craig.

Year 1 will be in **Class 1**, and will be based in what is currently the library. Mr Kershaw will be the class teacher, and Mrs Blinco will work alongside him.

Year 2 will be in **Class 2**, with Miss Wright teaching alongside Mrs Hardy.

Years 3 and 4 will once again make up **Class 3**, with Mrs K Lawman and Mrs Thornthwaite continuing to work with them.

Finally, **Class 4** will be home to our Year 5 and 6 children, with Mrs Crelling, Mrs J Lawman and myself working with them.

Mrs Fisher's role is changing, and she will provide release time cover in Early Years, Class 1 and Class 4.

We are also hoping to add some additional space to school, though it's more likely to be in the garden, rather than the previously advertised extension to the Music Room/Cosmos.
