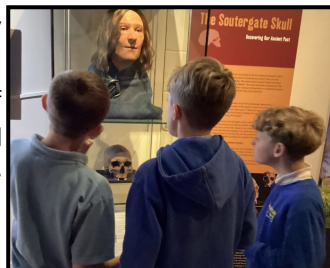
Making healthy choices

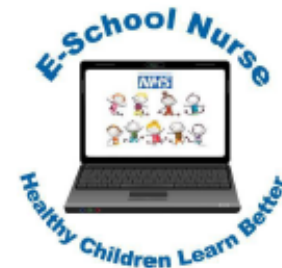
