The children had to work together to solve a range of problems in order to complete the activity - similar to an Escape Room.

We had some great feedback from the Happy Puzzle Company staff who, for example, thought Class 3 were working more in line with how they'd expect Year 5 and 6 children to be!



2026 Residential Trips

A quick heads up for parents of children who will be in Class 3 or Class 4 next year: we have our residential trips to Langdale (Class 3) and York (Class 4) booked, and we're in the process of putting all the arrangements in place.

We have again tried to keep the cost of each as low as possible. The Class 3 residential (21-22 May) will cost **£125** per child, while the Class 4 trip (3-5 June) will cost **£195** per child.

We will open payment facilities on SchoolHub in September so parents can start paying in instalments if that's helpful. We'll give full details of each trip in the new school year, but they've been very popular and hugely enjoyable in the past, and we hope that everyone will want to take part!
