Thanks again to everyone who responded to our recent Parent Survey.

There were a lot of positives, with lots of lovely comments around how much the children enjoy coming to school, how we communicate events and trips in advance and how we try to make everyone feel welcome.

There were also some points that we are looking to address over the next few weeks, starting with these

- Some parents say that **we don't offer enough chances for you to see your children's work**
→ We're going to invite everyone to have a look at their books after our Easter assemblies next week. We'll make this a regular feature following assemblies, and we'll also make books available at parents' evenings
- Some parents said that **we need to be more consistent with homework, and that Talk Homework seems to have stopped**
→ Talk Homework has been sent out this week, and it will continue to be sent out going forward

We are looking at how we can address other points, including making better use of Seesaw, spreading out events such as trips and discos and looking again at our payments systems.

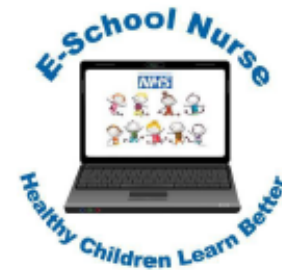
