Dear parents and carers,

Survey Results

Thank you to everyone who completed the parent survey we sent out last month. Whilst they were overall extremely positive, there was some really helpful developmental feedback that we're looking to work on over the coming weeks and months.

You'll see that I've summarised the results on page 2, but I'd like to briefly address some of the specific points brought up here:

Better/healthier lunches - There were a few comments about lunches, and how healthy they are. We have asked Kerry Weir from Orian - our catering contractors - to come into school for a meeting with parents, which will be held at **2.30pm** on **Thursday 21st November**. This will be a chance to understand how the menus are put together, and to ask any questions you may have, whether about specific meals or lunches more generally.

Communications - I understand that there is some frustration with the ScholarPack app. We are working directly with them presently to see if we can resolve the issues positively. We are also looking at options to reduce the number of apps we use.

SEN Support - Some comments said that we could be more proactive when it comes to putting support in place for children who are struggling with their learning, and who may have a special educational need. We are going to introduce regular **Surgeries with our SEN Team**, where you'll be able to raise any concerns directly with them. The first one will be on **27th November**, with slots bookable via School Hub.

Bullying - Two responses to our survey said our response hasn't been good enough to children being bullied. Bullying is utterly unacceptable in school, and if there are any ongoing matters, I would appreciate it if the parents concerned could contact me directly to ensure they are resolved.

Reports - One comment said that our reports could have more detail. We worked very hard on the format, to ensure they give a good summary of each child's experiences and achievements in school. However, they should be read in conjunction with meeting with your child's teacher at Parents' Evenings, and understood as being one part of how...

...we feed back to you.

Seesaw - We are considering how we ensure you're getting more regular updates on Seesaw in every class - you should see this happening over the next few weeks.

Parents' Evening - one comment mentioned that the last one in the year is too late. They have to be in line with reports going out, which in turn have to follow our receipt of the children's statutory assessments; the Year 6 results arrive on the second Tuesday in July. We have up to two other parents' evenings during the year - one for every child before October half-term, and a second in February where we invite parents in if there's something specific we need to discuss, such as a child finding a subject difficult, or us noticing an emerging talent that needs supporting. Thanks again for taking the time to complete the survey - I appreciate your feedback.
