Dear parents and carers,

Extension Proposal and Fundraising

As the village and school continue to thrive and grow, we find ourselves in a position where we need to expand our indoor teaching space.

We last did this in 2016, when we built Class 2. That project was supported superbly by our community in all sorts of ways, and as we approach a new build, we are reaching out for your help again.

We are looking to extend what is currently a small room in school – known as the Cosmos – in order to offer greater functionality. Currently, it is used for small groups and music lessons, but we intend to expand it so it is a more flexible teaching space that can be used for a range of provision. We also intend for it to be the new home for our library, and so to be a friendly, warm, welcoming space where the children can enjoy a good book.

Relocating the library, in turn, frees up an area that can be dedicated to splitting Year 1 and Year 2 into individual classes for the 2026-27 academic year. This change is expected to further elevate educational standards during the crucial early years, giving children more focused attention and tailored support as they progress.

Please be assured that any development will be managed in order to keep the impact on children to a minimum.

The total cost of the build is estimated to be around £40,000 - a very significant sum for a school our size. And so, across the second half of summer term, we intend to run a sponsored event for the children to take part in, and to have other opportunities for our community to be involved with fundraising towards the cost of the build.

If you know of any funding opportunities that may be available locally, such as through your employer, could you please contact Mr Peacock to discuss these directly. Any help would be very gratefully received.

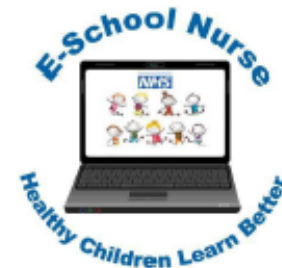
