May Half-Term / Dates to remember

When we return, we're right back into it straight away:

- Year 4 will complete the national Multiplication Tables Check during the first week back in school. The children don't need to do anything special to prepare - the assessment only lasts for a few minutes, and they've been practising hard in school over the last few weeks. We're really proud of how well the children have learned their tables this year!
- Class 4 go to York from Wednesday 3rd to Friday 5th June. We had a session in class on Monday afternoon this week looking at the plan for the trip and everyone sounds like they're looking forward to it!
- Year 1 will complete the national Phonics Screening Check during the second week back, from Monday 8th June. Again, the children have worked really hard, and have made some excellent progress this year.

Please ensure your Year 1 and Year 4 children are in school on the dates above, and let us know of any absences as soon as you can.

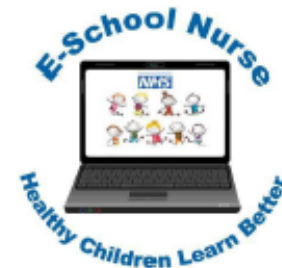
